Original full-width porch is partially enclosed on the right side and the entry door turned 90 degrees. Large additions off the rear and side of the hosue make it a non-contributing resource.

STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE:

This house occupies Lot #87 as shown on the 1898 Buell plan. Batchelder and Brown sold the lot in 1917 to Edward Paya, who also owned the adjacent lots #86 and #85. Paya was a carpenter and may have built this house. The first Burlington City Directory listing appears in 1921, for Roy J. Yandow, The house first appears on the 1926 Sanborn map. This house a non-contributing resource due to alterations to the original structure, including changing the location of the front door and enclosing the front porch, and large additions on the rear and side elevations.

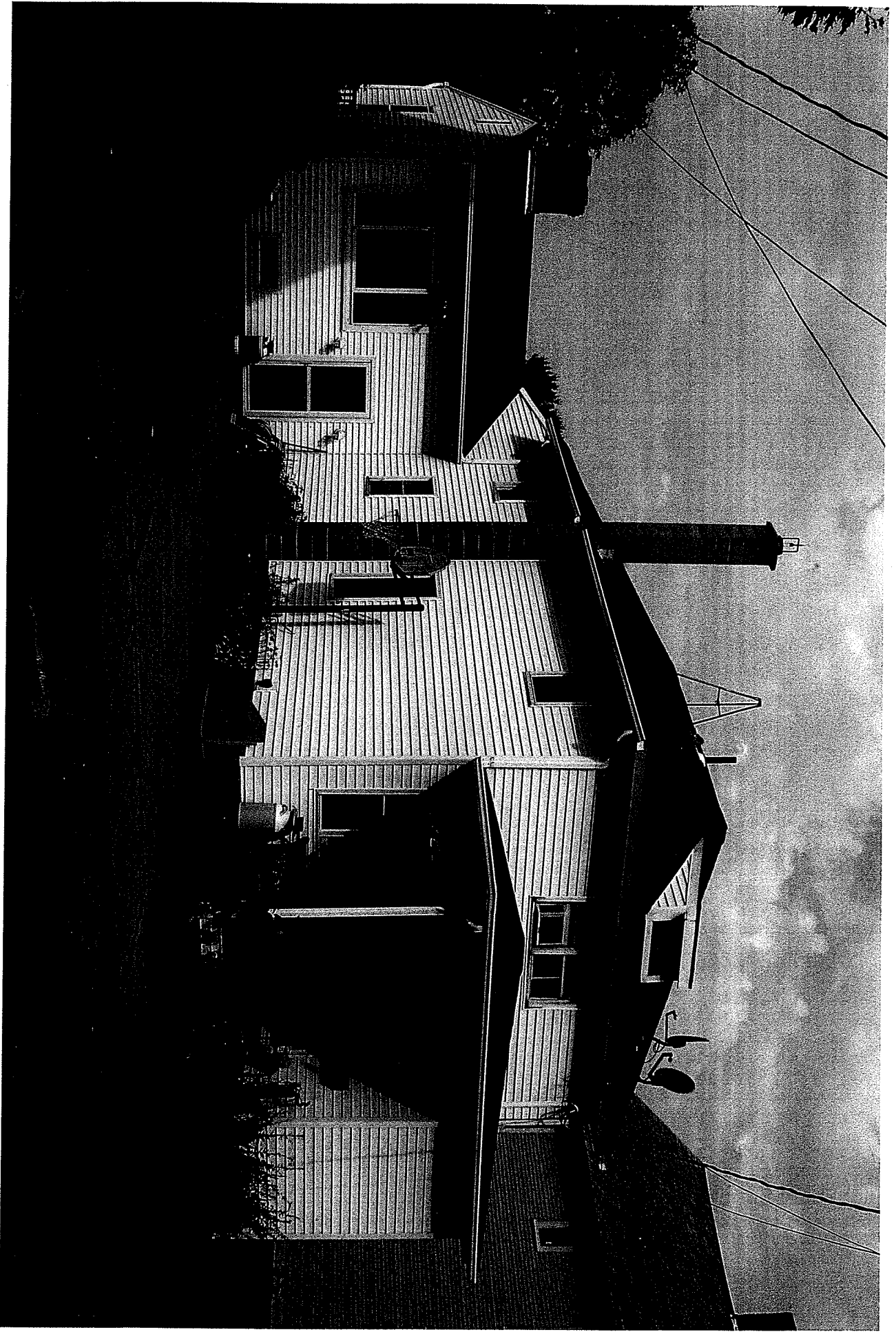
