No. 19. An act relating to burial depth in cemeteries.

(H.3)

It is hereby enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Vermont:

Sec. 1. 18 V.S.A. § 5319(b) is amended to read:

(b)(1) Interment of any human body in the earth shall not be made unless

the distance from the bottom of the outside coffin or body shall be at least five

three and one-half feet below the natural surface of the ground, excepting only

infants under four years of age, whose bodies shall be so interred that the

bottom of the outside coffin enclosing them shall be at least three and one half

feet below the natural surface of the ground or if buried without a coffin shall

be so interred that the bottom of the body shall be at least five feet below the

natural surface of the ground. Nothing in this subdivision shall be construed to

prohibit the interment of a human body at a depth greater than three and one-

half feet below the surface of the ground.
