Discussion: Burlington Stormwater Standards/SW Manual

- a. Request for input re: scope and formation of Burlington Stormwater Standards Workgroup (6 months?)
 - i. Composition of group: BCB rep, consultant representation, developer representation
- b. Draft Scope of work
 - i. Refining thresholds and requirements for post-construction stormwater management (based on type of development and size, level of risk)
 - ii. Clarifying/strengthening standards for new vs. redevelopment and/or existing impervious (especially when there is no hydrologic change).
 - iii. Examining opportunities for "alternative compliance" – i.e. offsite project/credits and/or payment of fee in lieu of
 1. Changing SW Billing credit manual to allow for treatment of runoff from ROW
 - iv. Examining possible zoning/form based code requirements such as GAR (Green Area Ratio) to ensure sustainability/green infrastructure items are addressed
 - v. Formalizing tree related standards
 - vi. Fees for project review
- c. Stormwater Manual development (longer term discussion)
