

Why Joining the Union Makes Sense

Unionized workers are paid more and have superior benefits compared to nonunion employees. In addition to long-time benefits like sick leave, vacation leave and paid holidays, AFSCME Local 1343 was able to win paid family leave for its City of Burlington members during the last contract negotiations.

A Union provides an enforceable means for its members to hold their employers accountable. Even well meaning employers and managers see the workplace differently than those of us who do the work on the frontlines, in the streets, the garages, parks, library, city offices and on the Marketplace. Being a member of the union gives you a legally bound process to grieve violations of the Collective Bargaining Agreement (CBA) by your boss(es). In addition, the union through its members and officials works to insure management abides by that agreement.

Union members have better job safety protections and have more legal protections exercising their rights in the workplace. The CBA also has legal protections in place if a member considers a job unsafe or dangerous to their health.
