NARRATIVE:

On June 24, 2020 at approximately 0433 hours Burlington Police Officers were dispatched to an activated burglar alarm at Ben & Jerry's at 36 Church St in Burlington, VT. Upon arrival police located a male subject fleeing the store. The subject known to police as Ibrahim Garelnabi was apprehended after a brief foot pursuit without further incident.

Further investigation revealed that Garelnabi forced entry through the locked front door of the closed business. Garelnabi then bagged up several items in a trash bag to include the cash register drawers and a safe before fleeing the store when police arrived.

Garelnabi currently has more than 10 active pending criminal cases in Chittenden County Vermont, one of which has court ordered curfew from 9PM-6AM stemming from theft and resisting arrest charges in 2019.

Garelnabi was charged with Burglary in violation of 13 VSA 1201 and violating his curfew court conditions in violation of 13 VSA 7559. Garelnabi was released by a Judge with a court appearance scheduled for later this morning at 10:30AM.

A person convicted of burglary in possession of a concealed weapon shall be imprisoned not more than 20 years or fined not more than \$10,000, or both.
