**BPD Press Release UPDATE: Missing Person**

For the past two days, divers with the Vermont State Police have used a variety of tools and techniques to continue the search for Barry Nelson, 73, the missing person described in the Burlington Police Department's Monday night press release. Today, Wednesday June 30, 2021, just after 1100 hours, the missing person was spotted in the waters of Lake Champlain, in the vicinity of the mouth of the Winooski River. Partners from the U.S. Customs and Border Protection's Plattsburgh Air Unit made the sighting from the air. Regrettably, Mr. Nelson was deceased. His remains have been recovered.

The Burlington Police Department recognizes the assistance and efforts of the Burlington Fire Department, the Colchester Police Department, Colchester Technical Rescue, the United States Coast Guard, the Vermont State Police, United States Customs and Border Protection, and others.

The Burlington Police Department also extends its deep sympathies to Mr. Nelson's family, friends, and loved ones in their bereavement.
