


BPD Press Release Update re stabbing on Church Street



BPD Press update regarding incident 21BU010397, July 9 2021:

Detectives identified the primary suspect in this Church Street-area stabbing as Eugene Missouri, 50, of St Albans. He was charged with aggravated assault with a deadly weapon and was flash-cited into court on Thursday. He was subsequently released on conditions following his arraignment.

Incident description: On July 9, 2021, at approximately 0227 hours, Burlington police officers were dispatched to the area of Church St. and Main St. for the report of an assault. During the initial investigation, officers were able to determine that a physical altercation had taken place on Church St. between Main St. and College St., which resulted in a victim being slashed across the neck and arm with a cutting instrument. The victim was treated at the University of Vermont Medical Center and received more than 70 stitches. Detectives initiated an investigation and were able to identify the alleged perpetrator as Eugene Missouri, 50, of St Albans, VT.

On Thursday July 22 2021 Mr. Missouri was charged with aggravated assault with a deadly weapon. He was arraigned and released on conditions.
