BPD is actively investigating the Armed Robbery that took place at Simon's Gas Station located on Park St.		

**NARRATIVE:**

On 28 December 2021, at approximately 2021 hours, Burlington Police responded to Simon's Gas Station located at 42 Park St for 911 call that the Clerk was being robbed. The 911 caller was a second employee inside the store who had walked out of the back room to observe a coworker with their arms in the air behind the counter with an unknown male next to them.

The male suspect is described as a white male, approximately 6'0" tall, approximately 175-200 lbs, with tattoos on his hands. The male suspect was wearing a camouflage jacket with a hooded sweatshirt under the jacket, blue jeans, brown work boots, and a light green gator pull mask. The male suspect was wearing a multi-color baseball hat with the front part of the hat to be a light grey and the back of the hat a darker grey. The male suspect displayed what appears to be a 4 to 6 inch folding knife while forcing the employee to open the register.

The male suspect stole the employee's cell phone to prevent them from calling the police. The male suspect threatened the clerk stating that if they called the police he would come back and slit the employee's throat. The male suspect had the employee get on their knees and place their hands behind their back. The suspect then had the employee lay on their stomach and not to get up. The male suspect fled on foot to an older model dark blue station wagon type vehicle that was parked in a nearby driveway on Park St. The vehicle did not have any registration plates

attached to the vehicle. The male suspect was chased by a customer who had arrived at the store when the male exited the store running away.

The male suspect fled the store with an undisclosed amount of cash and several packs of cigarettes.

Burlington Police Department is asking the public for help with identifying the male suspect in the attached photos. Also attached are photos of the tattoos on the hands of the suspect.
