SUSPECT DISPOSITION:		
Terrence Anderson was arrested and charged with Aggravated 1 st degree-Domestic Assault and Fentanyl Trafficking.		

NARRATIVE:

On January 09, 2022 at approximately 1602 hours, the Burlington Police Department received a 911 call from a victim who stated their boyfriend had pointed a firearm at them. The victim stated they were hiding in the bathroom and the boyfriend was in the other room. Dispatch advised responding officers the victim had disconnected the call and what now appeared to be in the presence of the boyfriend.

Officers arrived on scene and approached the residence. Officers made contact with the victim and boyfriend. The suspect was identified as Terrance Anderson, age 54. Preliminary investigation revealed Anderson pointed the firearm at the victim and stated "I'm going to shoot you and then kill myself." The victim grabbed their cell phone and hid in the bathroom calling 911.

Officers located a loaded 9mm Ruger hidden on top of clothes in a laundry basket covered with a shoebox. Anderson was taken into custody and transported back to the Burlington Police Department. Anderson's person was searched incident to arrest and was found to be in possession of (5 ½) five and half bundles of suspected Fentanyl and \$500 in cash.

A search warrant for Anderson's residence was granted by the Honorable Judge. Officers later executed a search warrant on a safe located inside the residence. Inside the safe, Officers discovered approximately \$17,300.00 in cash, large quantity of suspected Fentanyl, a large quantity of Oxycontin pills of various doses, a large bag of small ½ sized bags consistent with sale distribution, a large quantity of suspected heroin, a large plastic baggie with packaging containing smaller Ziploc bags with suspected heroin consistent with sale distribution, a scale, and two different caliber loaded magazines belonging to a firearm.

Anderson had \$5,000.00 bail set on him, 24 hours curfew, to be released to a responsible adult approved by the Courts, and to appear in Court on Tuesday, January 11, 2022 at 1030 hours.
