NARRATIVE:

On 01 May 2022, at approximately 0252 hours, Burlington Police Department dispatch received multiple calls about individuals involved in a verbal argument, followed by a gunshot.

Officers responded and recovered ballistics evidence consistent with a firearms discharge. Preliminary information suggests that two males were involved in a verbal altercation when one male displayed a firearm and pointed it at the other male. Witnesses stated the male discharged the firearm at the other male. At the time of police response, there were no reports of injury to any parties. The suspect(s) then fled the area in a vehicle.

This is the sixth gunfire incident in the city of Burlington in 2022.
