**NARRATIVE:**

On July 24, 2022, at approximately 2337 hours, Dispatchers from the Burlington Police Department received a 911 call about a male lying on the grassy area to be bleeding at the intersection Manhattan Drive and Rose St.

Officers arrived on scene as well as Burlington Fire Department to find a male to have significant injuries. Based on the evidence on scene, it was determined a vehicle drove up and over the sidewalk at the intersection, striking the male who was walking on the sidewalk, and throwing the male to the roadway. The vehicle immediately left the scene leaving the injured male in the roadway. Burlington Fire Department transported the male to the University of Vermont Medical Center's Emergency Department with serious non-life threatening injuries.

Burlington Police Department is asking the public for help. If anyone heard or saw a vehicle leaving the area quickly is asked to call the Burlington Police Department.
