## NARRATIVE:

On June 16, 2023, at approximately 1:47am, officers from the Burlington Police Department responded to a report of a violation of conditions of release (VCR) that occurred near Saint Paul Street.

On arrival, investigation revealed that Darnell Richardson, 33, of Colchester, had violated his condition of release. Richardson resisted arrest when taken into custody and was transported to Northwest State Correctional Facility (NWSCF) and lodged.

Earlier this month, on June 1, 2023, probable cause was established to support a charge of domestic assault against Richardson. Richardson was ordered active conditions, including to not have any contact with his victim.

On June 4, 2023, probable caused was established to support a charge of domestic assault against Richardson. Richardson was lodged at NWSCF on a $\$ 5,000$ bail and received a court order to appear.

A review of Richardson's criminal history shows he has one felony conviction, two misdemeanor charges, and one assaultive crime charge.
