Ezra Dillion was taken into custody for Assault and Robbery. The Honorable Judge set bail at \$5,000 and Mr.		

Dillion was transported to Northwest Correctional Facility with a court date of August 21, 2023 at 1030 hours

Investigation is still pending and this is preliminary information being released and is subject to change pending new information or leads.

NARRATIVE:

On 19 August 2023, at approximately 1059 hours, the Burlington Police Department's Dispatch Center received multiple 911 calls for a male holding another male at knife point in the area of Bank St and Pine St. Dispatch provided a description of the suspect and the suspect's clothing to include white male, wearing a yellow jacket and blue jeans.

Officers responding to the scene observed a white male matching the description in the area of Cherry St and Battery St. The Officer attempted to approach the male who immediately started running south on Battery St. A foot pursuit ensured with the suspect running in between the Hilton hotel and Courtyard Marriott hotel. The suspect, later identified as Ezra Dillion, was apprehended when he attempted to exit the parking garage located at 67 Cherry St. Dillion was taken into custody without further incident. A knife used in the Assault and Robbery was recovered as Dillion had discarded the knife while running from Officers. The investigation also lead to the recovery of the money Dillion forcibly removed from the victim at knife point.



The Honorable Judge set bail at \$5,000 and Mr. Dillion was transported to Northwest Correctional Facility with a court date of August 21, 2023 at 1030 hours.
