## **NARRATIVE:**

On July 10, 2024, at approximately 10:16am, officers with the Burlington Police Department, while on routine foot patrol in the vicinity of the Downtown Marketplace, were flagged down by a witness of an assault and robbery.

Investigation revealed Melody Phillips, 39, of Shelburne, assaulted and robbed a 72-year-old male while he was withdrawing money at a nearby ATM in the Downtown Marketplace. Phillips grabbed the victim's hand, the victim fell to the ground, and Phillips forcibly grabbed the victim's wallet and money. Philips then fled the scene. Officers set up a perimeter and began canvassing the area.

At approximately 12:18pm, Phillips was located in Winooski and taken into custody.

The arresting officer accompanied Phillips to court. Based on the safety concerns, the Deputy State's Attorney requested curfew. However, due to Phillips being unhoused, the judge did not set curfew but did ask if the Deputy State's Attorney would like to request bail. The Deputy State's Attorney responded not at this time. Instead, Phillips was released on conditions to not have contact with the victim and to stay off Church Street.
