

Parking During Construction

We're keeping a close eye on parking during construction, and are tracking utilization & availability.


Downtown Parking	On-Street	Off-Street
Percentage Available	Downtown Core	City Garages
Thursday, 3/8: Morning	60%	24%
Thursday, 3/8: Evening / Night	25%	58%
Saturday, 3/10: Morning	74%	57%
Saturday, 3/10: Evening / Night	21%	31%
Sunday, 3/11: Morning	58%	54%
Sunday, 3/11: Afternoon	1%	35%
Sunday, 3/11: Night	52%	76%

NOTES:

On-Street Downtown Core, times of recording: 8:00am, 9:00pm, + Sunday 12:00p

Downtown Core parking is generally bounded by Pearl Street on the north, South Union Street on the east, Maple Street on the south, and Lake Street on the west.

Off-Street City Garages, times of recording: 10:00-11:00am, 6:00-7:00pm + Sunday 9:30-10:00am, 1:30-2:00pm, and 9:00-9:30pm

Bank Street Closure

 Week of April 9th: Bank Street will be closed to allow a new sewer line to be installed.
Open for business deliveries.

Noise / Vibration Update

- Starting early to mid-May: Installation of sheeting along Bank Street will begin
- Anticipated to last 3 weeks.
- Expect intermittent vibrations throughout the 7:00am-5:00pm work period.

Mass Demolition

 Expected to be completed by end of June 2018.

H-Pile Installation for Foundation

- Expected to begin in July 2018.
- Will last 4 months: Anticipated completion by end of October 2018.
