ODDINIANCE 6 A

It is hereby Ordained by the City Council of the City of Burlington as follows:

- Section 1. This ordinance is enacted to raise revenue for municipal purposes pursuant to the Charter
- of the City of Burlington, Act No. 298, Acts of 1949, Sections 48III and 48XXIV. Its purpose is to increase
- 3 the existing City of Burlington Hotel and Motel Tax from two (2) percent of gross receipts to four (4)
- 4 percent, and to increase restaurant, amusement, and admissions taxes on gross receipts for one fiscal year
- from two (2) percent to two and one-half (2.5) percent. The City Council hereby finds that these increases
- are necessary or convenient to maintain existing levels of services to the City's residents.
- Section 2. Chapter 21, Offenses and Miscellaneous Provisions, of the Code of Ordinances of the City of
 Burlington is hereby amended by amending Sec. 31, thereof to read as follows:

- 12 (B) Hotel and Motel Tax: There is hereby imposed a business occupation tax upon all persons
 13 engaged in the hotel or motel business of whatever name or character within the City of
 14 Burlington. The tax imposed shall be at a rate of <u>four (4)two (2)</u> percent of gross receipts from
 15 taxable business, as herein defined, done per monthly period in accordance with the
 16 provisions of this section.

- 19 year commencing on July 1, 2024, and ending on June 30, 2025, the restaurant,
