4. Public Service Application Discussion

ANEW Place – Independence Place

- Program was well thought out.
- Concern that the number of beneficiaries was not very high and that the evaluation of outcomes would be a challenge.
- Question: What happens to clients after the program? How do clients raise \$2000?

ECHO – ECHO Early Learning

- The need presented and the sustainability of the program was slightly weaker than other applications.
- Program strengths in integrating equity considerations into their program design.
- Impressive impact in terms of the number of beneficiaries served.

CVOEO – Volunteer Income Tax Assistance (VITA)

- Very strong program design and impact.
- Question around the budget as presented, but overall the group feels comfortable with moving forward.
- Suggestion that include a diverse population and language skills as they recruit volunteers for their program.

<u>Lund – Early Childhood Education Program</u>

• A very strong program will a good impact, there is just a suggestion around how they could tailor their program to specific populations to increase the impact.

ReSOURCE - YouthBuild

- A strong program that works in three really important areas: workforce, youth and weatherization while benefiting a sector with strong labor needs.
- A slight weakness is the relatively small number of beneficiaries compared to the budget.
